The Need the Holy Spirit

Dear brothers and sisters, I wish you a happy feast of Pentecost! This is the birthday of the Church. There are countless reasons the Scripture speaks about the need of the Holy Spirit; but the important one is: He is the third person of the Holy Trinity; we live in the Trinitarian God.

Jesus was filled with the Holy Spirit: "Behold My Servant ... I have put My Spirit upon Him ..." [Is. 42:1]. When Jesus was baptized the Spirit of God came upon Him [Matt. 3:16]. The Father's full affirmation and identification of Jesus as Beloved Son and our Savior. So too, His followers need to be filled with His Spirit – through Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders - to direct our lives.

To produce Christ-like character: The fruit of the Spirit is summarized as follows: love, joy, peace, patience, endurance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control [Gal. 5:22-23]. These virtuous traits are a description of Christ-like character. I cannot manufacture these virtues in my life without the help of the Holy Spirit.

To effectively walk in our calling: Jesus engaged in His career as a carpenter prior to the Spirit uniquely coming upon Him, to begin His earthly public ministry. You cannot effectively walk in your calling apart from the Spirit.

To properly share the Gospel: "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me ... anointed me, ... to proclaim good news to the poor ..." [Is. 61:1]. To effectively bring the gospel, we need to be empowered, guided, and filled with the Spirit. The disciples, too, waited to receive the Holy Spirit to begin their mission.

To have victory over the flesh: Many of us have struggled with life-dominating sin. We all know the battle between God's Spirit and our flesh. We can rejoice in the work of God's Spirit making progressive victory over the flesh a reality [Rom. 8].

Come Holy Spirit! Fill my heart and kindle in me the fire of your love that I may listen to your guidance always and enjoy the peace and joy in the Lord!
