Evangalization – Families, Schools of Human Growth

That families, through their life of prayer and love, become ever more clearly "schools of true human growth".



Are you Faithful or Fearful?

Dear brothers and sisters,

A question was put to Francis of Assisi (1182-1226) who was hoeing his garden when one of his brothers in Christ put the question to him. "Suppose you knew for certain that you were going to die and meet the Lord at the stroke of midnight tomorrow. How would you spend your time between now and then?" "Come what may," he answered, "I would finish hoeing my garden."

The scripture readings for this weekend invite us to become engaged in a similar reflection. What would you do if you knew that this day would be your last? What would you not do? How would you prepare to meet God? Where would you go? With whom would you spend your remaining hours? Would you be fearful or be faithful to your daily living; and be undisturbed or troubled?

Jesus challenged his disciples then, and today you and me, to lend our attention to such questions, he prefaced his teaching with a counsel against fear saying, "Do not live in fear. Let faith be the guiding force in our lives. Those who live by faith and not in fear are to conduct themselves as conscientious stewards. Such stewardship can be realized only when faith is unencumbered by fear and empowered by love.

As we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we see in her the faithful living, and never the fearful living. The Assumption becomes the reward for her faithfulness; the same is promised to all of us.

To that end, we might do well to take those words of St. Francis de Sales (1567-1622) to heart: "Have no fear for what tomorrow may bring. The same loving God who cares for you today will take care of you tomorrow and every day. God will either shield you from suffering or give you unending strength to bear it. Be at peace then, and put aside all anxious thoughts and imaginations." (Mt. 10:28; Rev. 2:10)

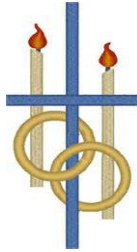
