The Lost are to be Sort

Dear brothers and sisters,
Getting lost or being lost, lost in life, etc. are the experiences of every person in the world. How does one find the life again? It is by the grace of God. Jesus came to seek what was lost. He came for sinners and invites them to eat and rejoice with him. Jesus teaches us that when people get lost, how do we welcome them back? He says a parable for men, parable for women and parable for a family. People get lost in various ways. Firstly, 'Innocently' like the sheep: The shepherd goes in search of the lost and brings them back to the flock. Secondly, 'Ignorantly' like the lost coin: The woman searches diligently, sweeps the house and finds the lost one; and rejoices with her friends. Thirdly, 'Intentionally' like the prodigal son: He planned to get away from his family; claimed his share; travelled to the country of his choice; squandered his wealth; finally ended up in the pigsty starving. His father waited for his coming and ran to kiss and welcome him. Fourthly, 'Intelligently' like the older son: he was lost within his family. He followed the commands of the father, but did not experience the father's love. The father goes out to welcome his elder son too. He complained and resisted. The brother was not welcoming his brother.

In all these, we see the Father's love for the lost ones. He seeks and searches the lost ones. There is a big difference between an animal being lost, a thing being lost and a person being lost. From the part of the person, the Lord expects repentance. "Have I any pleasure in the death of the wicked, declares the Lord God, and not rather that he should turn from his way and live?" [Ezekiel 18:23] When one repents, there is joy in the family, joy among friends, joy in the neighborhood, joy among the angels of God and joy in heaven.

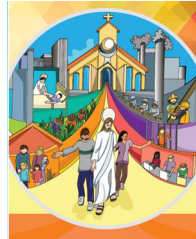


Unpack the Mysteries of Revelation

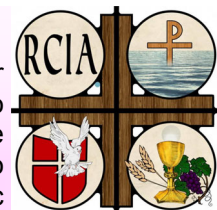

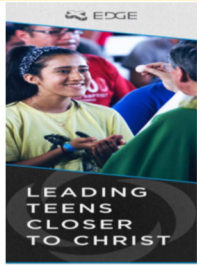

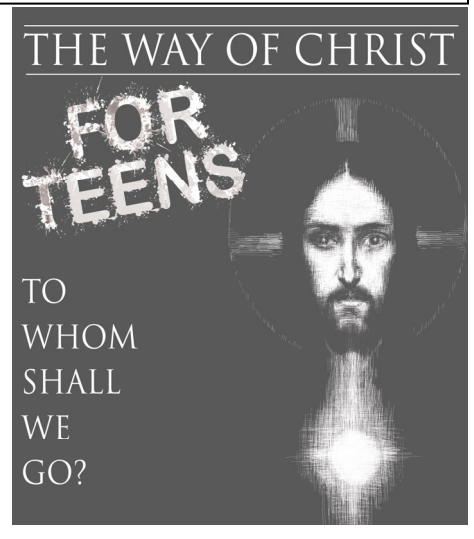
6th-8th Grade Ministry

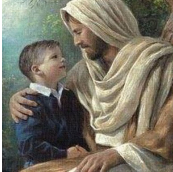

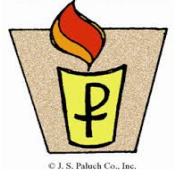


El día de la independencia de Mexico se celebrara el día 15 de septiembre.

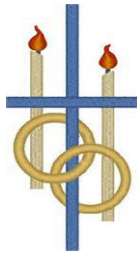
