A Glass of Water or A Drop of Water

Dear brothers and sisters,
For a thirsty person, a glass of cold water means 'a sea of warm love'. It's a sample of the smallest act of charity commonly practiced. Jesus uses this phrase "cup of cold water" twice. (Matt. 10:42; Mk. 9:41). One is for caring for little ones; and other for welcoming. He assured reward for this little act.

In Matthew 25:31-46, Jesus tells us that we'll be judged by how we care for our brethren: feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, invite in strangers, clothe the naked, and visit those who were sick and in prison. In short, do unto others whatever they need from you. It's important for us to use our blessings, to the best of our ability, to care and serve others. (Jas. 2:14-17).

Former baseball superstar Darryl Strawberry shared his testimony. He spoke about his many achievements; also about weaknesses and failures with admirable honesty. He finally surrendered his life to Christ, he was transformed into a new man. He summarized his whole career this way: When I get to the end of my life, God's not going to ask, "How many grand slams did you hit?" He's going to ask, "What did you do for my kingdom?" *He's exactly right*; (rewards, championships, rings, titles, money, status, connections, and all the rest of it) don't matter in eternity.

A glass of cold water we gave to a thirsty ones; a smile of love and care to the brothers and sisters, will matter more than home runs or touchdowns or the size of our bank account. The rich man neglected to care for Lazarus' illness, hunger, loneliness, etc. If he had given the glass of water, he need not ask for 'a drop of water' now to quench his thirst! Let us not neglect the acts of charity, when you can. Let your blessings be a blessing to others.

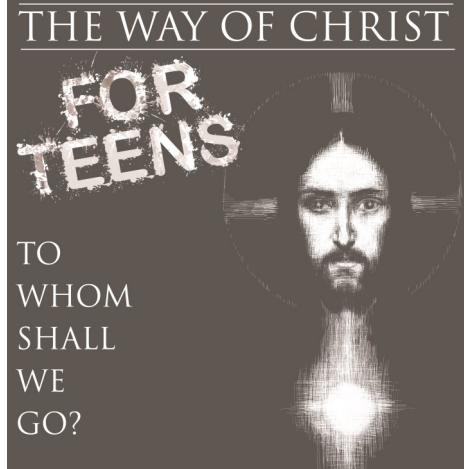

Diocese of Tyler: Ethics & Integrity / Safe Environment Program

As Christian adults, we have a moral and legal responsibility and are entrusted by God with the spiritual, emotional and physical well being of minors and vulnerable adults as they participate in activities within or sponsored by our parish and our Diocese. It is our responsibility and commitment to provide an environment which is safe and nurturing.

General: An Acceptance Certificate for Service (ACS) is required of all Church personnel - Clergy, religious, seminarians, paid employees and volunteers engaged in ministry with minors and vulnerable adults. The ACS is granted after completing the required background check and Safe Environment training; commitment to the Code of Ethics and Integrity for Conduct of Church Personnel / Volunteers is also required.

Background Check: Church personnel / volunteers must register with their parish administrator by filling out a registration form. Once they are entered into the database, they will receive e-mails about the background check and the Code of Conduct. The cost of the background check is \$16. You must complete the Background Check and acknowledge the Code of Conduct before you may attend the training.

Training: Before service begins and every three years thereafter, church personnel / volunteers will take the training, in which they will view Praesidium's CASE video and participate in facilitated discussion. During years 2 and 3, all will complete ongoing education online.
