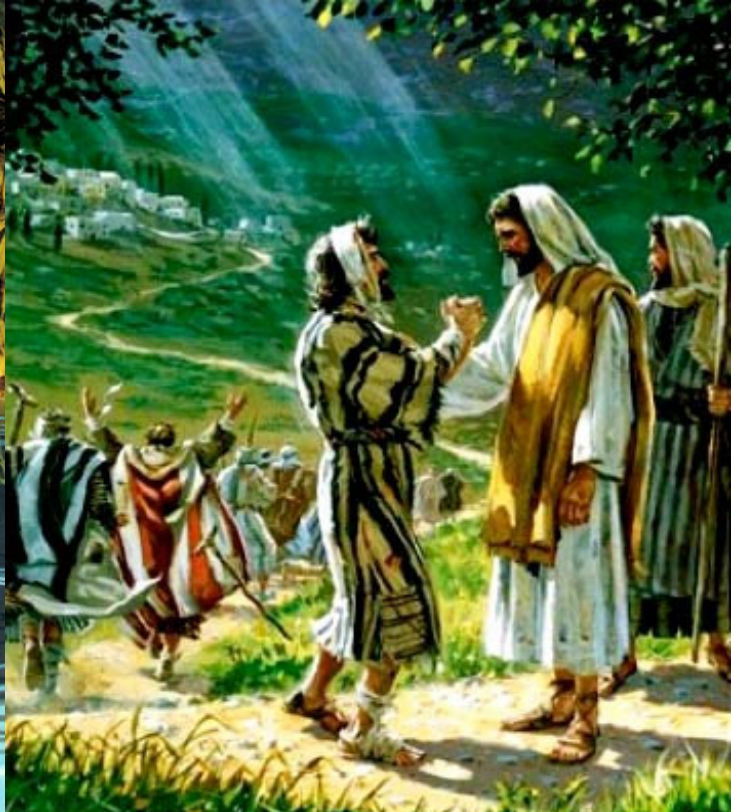

Faithfulness is Gratefulness

Dear brothers and sisters,
Gratitude is the gravity that holds us in the orbit of God's glory. It begins with recognizing what we have...and then directing the goodness back to the giver. It is like seeing leaves and connecting them

to the root.

In the readings, we hear of leprosy. Leprosy is a highly contagious disease; it keeps one from his society and family as "an outcast" or "a person to be avoided." This is not a needed situation for anyone.

Naaman was instructed by the prophet Elisha to plunge himself seven times in river Jordan; even though he wanted the prophet to touch him. The ten lepers were told by Jesus to show themselves to the priests; they were cleansed on their way. It is their humble obedience to God's word that healed them. But how did they show their gratitude? It depends on how grave and desperate they were to receive the healing.

Naaman showed his gratitude by taking two mule loads of earth and promised to faithfully worship the true God, no more pagan gods. The Samaritan leper came back to give thanks and received the grace of complete healing, the salvation. These men connected their healing to their healer.

A farmer had oxen. As he was feeding them, one of his oxen, grateful for his care, fell to licking his bare arm. He said to himself, "This poor dumb brute is really more grateful to me than I am to God." *Please read, Isaiah 1:3.* If the birds and animals could sing and show their gratitude, why not us?

Gratitude is the gravity that binds us together with God and to one another, with our family and friends in loving relationship. Let us count our blessings and be grateful to the giver of all blessings!

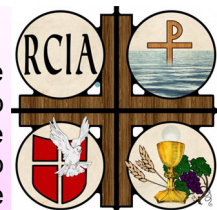

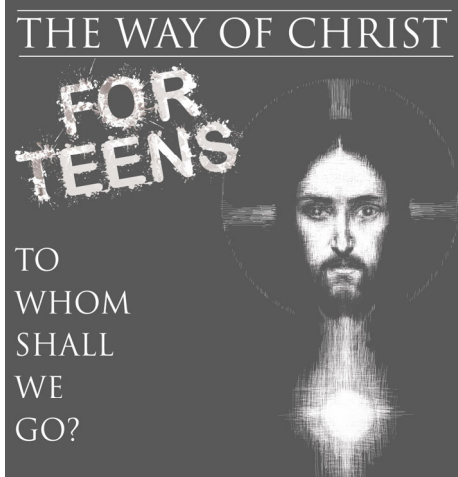

Diocese of Tyler: Ethics & Integrity / Safe Environment Program

As Christian adults, we have a moral and legal responsibility and are entrusted by God with the spiritual, emotional and physical well being of minors and vulnerable adults as they participate in activities within or sponsored by our parish and our Diocese. It is our responsibility and commitment to provide an environment which is safe and nurturing.



General: An Acceptance Certificate for Service (ACS) is required of all Church personnel - Clergy, religious, seminarians, paid employees and volunteers engaged in ministry with minors and vulnerable adults. The ACS is granted after completing the required background check and Safe Environment training; commitment to the Code of Ethics and Integrity for Conduct of Church Personnel / Volunteers is also required.

Background Check: Church personnel / volunteers must register with their parish administrator by filling out a registration form. Once they are entered into the database, they will receive e-mails about the background check and the Code of Conduct. The cost of the background check is \$16. You must complete the Background Check and acknowledge the Code of Conduct before you may attend the training.

Training: Before service begins and every three years thereafter, church personnel / volunteers will take the training, in which they will view Praesidium's CASE video and participate in facilitated discussion. During years 2 and 3, all will complete ongoing education online. You must register for the training in the church office.

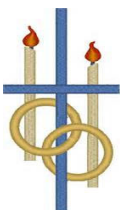
