### Glory of God vs Joy of Men

Dear brothers and sisters,  
 Psalms 15 says, "Lord, when your glory appears, my joy will be full." How do we understand this? "The heavens declare the glory of God and the firmament shows forth His handiwork." [Psalms 19] God's creation reveals the glory of God. And He created and crowned man with glory and honor to rule over and perfect it [Psalms 8:5-6]

From the Garden of Eden until the tower of Babel there were no translators. All spoke one language. God was pleased. When the 'will to power' intruded, both the glory of God and the joy of men disappeared. Yes, God called us to have dominion over the earth to the glory of God. The glory of God is man fully alive. When Neil Armstrong landed on the moon he said, "That's one small step for man; one giant leap for mankind." This is an incredible achievement but sounded like another 'Tower of Babel'. Whose glory is revealed? Whenever we do things to make 'a name for ourselves' God is not glorified; and it ends in chaos and confusion. "He that speaks of himself seeks his own glory." [Jn. 7:18; Prov. 25:27] Therefore, seek the glory of God; and from one another. [Jn. 5:44]

The seven sons in the book of Maccabees, guided by their mother, lived and died joyfully glorifying God; thus they are able to share the glory of God. If we reveal the glory of God while living, we would die joyfully and see the glory of God.

We can't put God in a box, but he can – in the Ark of the covenant, in the tabernacles today. C.S. Lewis once said, "A man can no more diminish God's glory by refusing to worship Him than a lunatic can put out the sun by scribbling 'darkness' on the wall of his cell..." The more we refuse to give glory to God, the less joyful we are in our lives. Let us acknowledge the glory of God in all we do, our joy will be full. My prayers and blessings! *Msgr. Xavier*

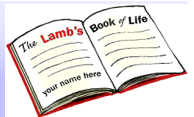

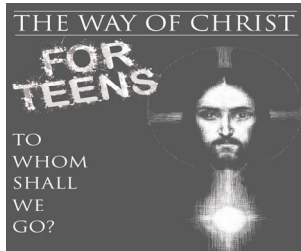

**Diocese of Tyler: Ethics & Integrity / Safe Environment Program**

**General:** An Acceptance Certificate for Service (ACS) is required of all Church personnel - Clergy, religious, seminarians, paid employees and volunteers engaged in ministry with minors and vulnerable adults. The ACS is granted after completing the required background check and Safe Environment training; commitment to the Code of Ethics and Integrity for Conduct of Church Personnel / Volunteers is also required.

**Background Check:** Church personnel / volunteers must register with their parish administrator by filling out a registration form. Once they are entered into the database, they will receive e-mails about the background check and the Code of Conduct. The cost of the background check is \$16. **You must complete the Background Check and acknowledge the Code of Conduct before you may attend the training.**

**Training:** You must register for the training in the church office. Before service begins and every three years thereafter, church personnel / volunteers will take the training, in which they will view Praesidium's CASE video and participate in facilitated discussion. During years 2 and 3, all will complete ongoing education online.

**Why do we pray for the dead?**

According to the Catholic Encyclopedia, the clearest Bible reference about prayers for the dead is from the Second Book of Maccabees. When soldiers were preparing the bodies of their slain comrades for burial they discovered they were wearing amulets taken from a pagan temple which violated the law of Deuteronomy, so they prayed that God would forgive the sin these men had committed.

The New Testament echoes this notion in the second letter of Timothy when Paul prays for someone who died named Onesiphorus, saying: "May the Lord grant him to find mercy from the Lord on that day."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church also has something to say about prayers for the dead, stating: "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" (1030).

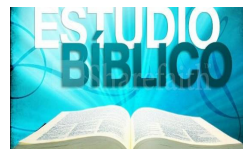

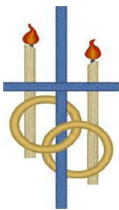
