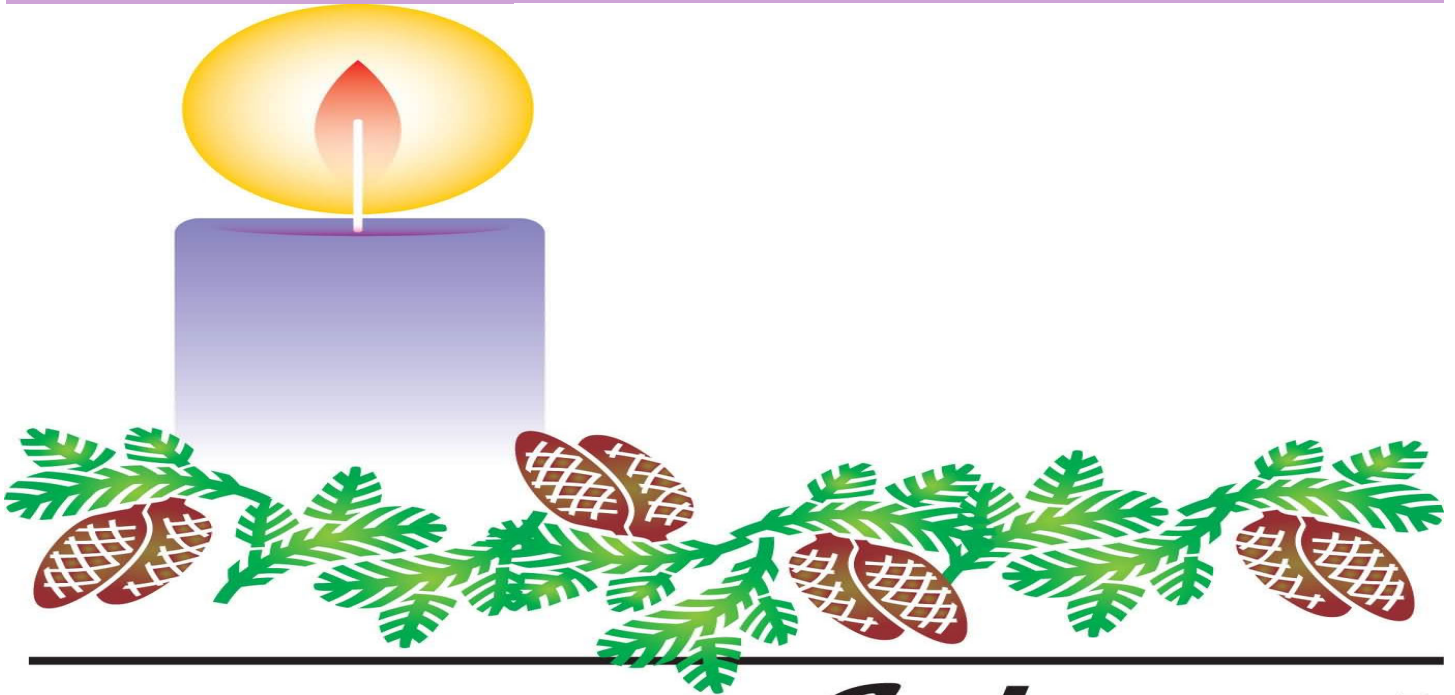

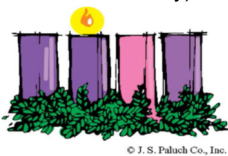

### Advent: The First Step to a New Life

Dear brothers and sisters,  
We are beginning a New Liturgical year; a New Year in the Church. I pray that you will have a Spirit filled walk with Jesus during this Year of the Eucharist.

We begin with the season of Advent. The word "Advent" is from the Latin "Adventus," which means "coming." It encompasses the four Sundays before Christmas. The vision it gives is twofold: it looks back to the first coming of Christ at Bethlehem and it looks to the future when Christ will come again. In the interval between these two events, we find meaning for our life and celebrate it as a Christian.

Christ came to show us what life can and should be. He gave us true and valid principles by which we can live true and valid lives. But Jesus knew that the human heart could not live in isolation. He formed the Church around the concept of a people held together by love. In that community we discover unlimited possibilities and meaning. Therefore, I invite you to begin this year living everyday with your family, friends and your spiritual companions.

Bishop Stickland has decreed this new liturgical year as the "Year of the Eucharist: Fostering Reverence for the Real Presence" in the Diocese of Tyler. As we journey through this year, it is Bishop's hope that we may seek ways to deepen our personal faith and understanding of the tremendous gift of the Real Presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Blessed sacrament. May the Blessed Virgin Mary intercede for us as we seek to reverence the Eucharistic Face of her Son more powerfully in our journey of faith. You are invited to spend time praying in front of the Blessed Sacrament in Eucharistic Adoration on Wednesdays and First Friday in the chapel.

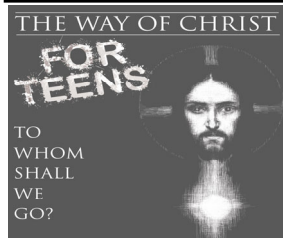

**Diocese of Tyler: Ethics & Integrity / Safe Environment Program**

**General:** An Acceptance Certificate for Service (ACS) is required of all Church personnel - Clergy, religious, seminarians, paid employees and volunteers engaged in ministry with minors and vulnerable adults. The ACS is granted after completing the required background check and Safe Environment training; commitment to the Code of Ethics and Integrity for Conduct of Church Personnel / Volunteers is also required.

**Background Check:** Church personnel / volunteers must register with their parish administrator by filling out a registration form in the church office. Once they are entered into the database, they will receive e-mails about the background check and the Code of Conduct. The cost of the background check is \$16. You must complete the Background Check and acknowledge the Code of Conduct before you may attend the training.

**Training:** You must register for the training in the church office. Before service begins and every three years thereafter, church personnel / volunteers will take the training, in which they will view Praesidium's CASE video and participate in facilitated discussion. During years 2 and 3, all will complete ongoing education online.

**The Advent Wreath**

The lights of the candles on the Advent Wreath break through the darkness, reminding us of the Light of Christ that we anticipate during this holy season.

The Advent Wreath is very symbolic. The evergreens used for the wreath itself are a reminder of continuous life. The shaping of them into a circle reinforces that meaning. The circle is also a sign of everlasting life as well as the eternity of God.

The four candles used, three purple and one pink, mark the Sundays of Advent before Christmas. The purple candles are reminders that this should be a time of prayer and sacrifice to prepare us for the second coming of Christ. On the third Sunday, the pink candle is lit to announce Gaudete Sunday, a Sunday of rejoicing for Christ is coming near. With the lighting of that candle, the light has won out over the darkness (three candles lit vs. the one that remains unlit).

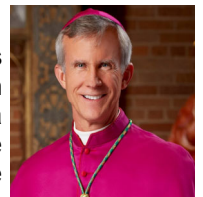

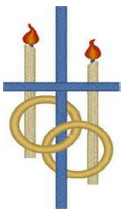
