# **Divining the Divine Mercy**



Dear brothers and sisters, Divine Mercy gets to the heart of Sacred Scripture. Divine Mercy is the Gospel. It's the good news. And so, it gets to the very center

of our faith. (CCC.1849)

Mercy is "love's second name." as St. John

Paul said. Divine Mercy is when God's love meets us and helps us amid our suffering and sin. It's always the Lord stepping out in compassion to help us poor, weak, and broken sinners. Every good we receive is an expression of Divine Mercy.

Jesus didn't reveal some new Gospel when he appeared to St. Faustina. Why did He appear to Faustina? God sometimes appears to mystics because He has a prophetic message for a particular time in history; He uses particular men and women to share His message: to remind us of something that's been forgotten, or it's a warning, or a message of comfort, or a call to conversion, etc. (Heb. 1:1-4) His message through Faustina was: His mercy for us sinners. Why now?

St. John Paul explained it best. First, he pointed out all kinds of blessings in our contemporary society. For instance, modern technology has done so much to make life easier for us. Just think of e-mail, cell phones, smartphones, and air-conditioning. All these things are blessings. Yet, amid these blessings, evil has a reach and power in our day like never before.

Therefore, he says, "Be not afraid." Because, "Where sin increased, grace abounded all the more." (Rom. 5:20) In other words, God is not outdone by evil. So, in a time of great evil, God wants to give even greater graces, and in our time, the graces are huge, precisely because there's so much sin. God's mercy is bigger than any mistake that you have made! Please read: Mt. 5:7; 9:13; & Heb.4:16. Approach the Lord for His mercy, you'll receive it. Blessings! Msgr. Xavier





**Dress Code: First Holy Communion & Confirmation** 

Girls: Dresses are NOT to be shorter than the knee or longer than the ankle. NO FORMALS. For those receiving First Holy Communion, the dress code is white; for the Confirmands, any color is permitted. Dress shoes or dress sandals (no tennis shoes). No dresses with spaghetti straps or without sleeves will be permitted. Without proper dress you may not be permitted to participate in the sacraments.

Boys: 1st Holy Communion: Dress shirt must be white, long or short sleeve. Dress pants may be white, navy blue or black. Ties - white, navy blue or black;

Boys: Confirmation: Dress shirt of any solid color. Dark dress pants - navy blue or black; (no tennis shoes please); Suit coats or jackets are optional (not a requirement).

- 1. Catholic Baptism Certificate
- 2. Active and Practicing Catholic.
- 3. Attendance at regular Faith Formation classes.
- 4. Regular monthly Confessions & Sunday Masses
- 5. Parents Confirmation classes: Each candidate's parents must have attended TWO classes. Proof is needed.
- **6. Sponsors** must have attended a class either here or in their own parish; and need to send a letter from their pastor by April 15th.
- 7. Confirmation name: Candidates are confirmed with their baptismal name. It is strongly encouraged for candidates to select a saint to study and emulate as a patron for confirmation.

We know that sometimes our story can give others hope, direction, encouragement, and sometimes it can just let them see that obstacles along the path have a purpose.

What is the difference between....
the special graces promised by Jesus for devout communicants on Mercy Sunday, and the plenary indulgence for Divine Mercy Sunday devotions that was instituted several years ago by Pope John Paul II?
Are they the same thing?



The main difference, of course, is that an "indulgence" is something offered to the faithful by the Church, as the keeper of the keys of the kingdom, with authority to "bind and loose." (Mt 16:17-19)

The special graces of Mercy Sunday, on the other hand, were promised directly by our Lord, through a prophetic revelation given to St. Faustina (see Diary of St. Faustina, 699).

The Church has not officially ruled that this particular promise was an authentic supernatural revelation, but the Church has discerned, in various ways, that there is nothing that violates Catholic doctrine in this promise.

Novena began on Good Friday.
