

This process is an essential commitment of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* and our diocese. As before, the CPC must be renewed every three years in order to remain in compliance.

No dresses with spaghetti straps or without sleeves will be permitted. Without proper dress you may not be permitted to participate in the sacraments.

Boys: 1st Holy Communion: Dress shirt must be white, long or short sleeve. Dress pants may be white, navy blue or black. Ties - white, navy blue or black;

Boys: Confirmation: Dress shirt of any solid color. Dark dress pants - navy blue or black; (no tennis shoes); Suit





Begins from June 3rd (Monday.) For current registered members of the parish only \$10 per child. "First Come, First Served." From the month of August, \$30 per child.






