Power-Prayer Vs Prayer-Power

Dear brothers and sisters,
We are praying people! No doubt. But does our prayer (external) have power? Or does our power (internal) have prayer? What do I mean by this? God waits to hear the prayer that has power - faith without doubt or fear from within!

A synagogue official comes to Jesus and prays for his power over his daughter. Jesus went off disregarding the message of death, commotion of the people, weeping and wailing, being ridiculed, etc. Jesus said, "Just have faith; no doubt." He took the 12 year old child by His powerful hand and healed her.

A woman suffering for 12 years - persistent problem, discouraging distress, medical failures, financial drain, deteriorating physically, socially and emotionally, etc., approached Jesus with a mind-set - "If I just touch His garments, I shall get well". The moment she touched, Jesus felt the power has gone out of Him! A prayer that drew power from Jesus! The crowd pressed in on Him; none of them received the power of Jesus but she.

The things in your house work because of electricity. Electricity is an invisible power that gives you visible privileges. It turns the lights on, turns the TV on, turns the toaster on, and turns the oven on; all that stuff is working in your house because you've got one invisible power shooting through there called electricity. But none of those things work even though they have access to electricity until you flip on a switch. You've got to make a connection before the stuff that's there works. Every believer in Jesus Christ has stuff that works, prayer-power.

Prayer is like electricity because it empowers us by connecting us to the source of that power. Your prayer is "power-prayer or prayer-power," depending on your connection (faith) with God. Pray in faith for the power of God to be at work in you.

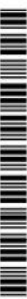
