### Come Apart or Fall Apart

Dear brothers and sisters,  
Someone has said that modern life can be spelled in three words: "Hurry, worry, bury." Once a senator was asked, as he rushed breathlessly, "What do you think of the world crisis?" He replied, "Don't bother me; I'm in a hurry to make a radio speech.

A crisis like this is no time to think." Jesus would have us come apart and rest awhile; if we don't, we will fall apart!

We are a people, prophets, and apostles with a vision and mission! We live to accomplish it in our families and jobs. When the disciples returned and reported their accomplishment to Jesus, he said, "Come apart to rest!" Really! It is not a suggestion but an instruction to His apostles. Why? 'Our humanity's problem stems from our inability to sit quietly in a room alone.' For many of us, 'We will fall apart if we come apart!'

As many of you know, life and ministry can be physically and emotionally exhausting, especially when dealing with the family, children and hurts of people – deserted people – lonely, abandoned, neglected, and sick. You need rest! Find a deserted place to rest and recuperate to care for the deserted people. Rest time is not a waste of time. It is time to gather fresh strength. In the long run, we shall do more by sometimes doing less.

"Rest" is a divine plan! God worked for six days and rested on the seventh. Jesus invites us to rest, he invites us to spend time in His company and with one another, away from the demands and distractions of our daily work. It's about report, reflection and renewal of our work; to look inward, to examine our hearts, and to align our lives with the will of God. It's a holy moment or a holy hour, just like being on the weekends with Jesus.

Our Sunday celebration with our church family could be "come apart to be with Jesus with your family; so that we don't fall apart"; but be filled with God's grace!

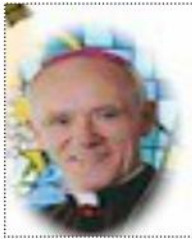

### 5 Powerful Ways [after a retreat] to Keep Your Heart on Fire for God

Is your heart on fire for God? Yes, after this "mountaintop experience" during the retreat, your heart is full of love and joy. How to grow & glow in it!

1. Pray Daily: To keep your faith burning bright, start with the basics – prayer. Regular communication with Him will help keep the passion for Him burning. Even if you don't know how to pray, ask God to fill your heart with a desire and hunger for more of Him.
2. Read and meditate on God's Word. (Read the daily Mass readings) When you meditate the Word becomes alive in you. Remember the example of the Emmaus Disciples. (Lk. 24:32) Their hearts were burning within them. Read Psalm 1:2-3; and Rom. 10:17.
3. Serve Others: Whenever I serve others, I always get a joyful feeling inside. Join one of the ministries in the church. People go for mission trips and come back fully on fire. For God. Be the hands and feet of Jesus to set your heart on fire for God. When you follow Christ's example and serve other people, you will see God's love in action and it will stir your heart closer to God's. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. [Romans 12:11]
4. Fellowship with Others who are on fire for God. Surround yourself and fellowship with other believers. It is so important to our faith walk. Try to attend a weekly group through the church and always leave feeling fired up for God.
5. Share the good news to a non-believer everyday. Choose a different non-believer and make an effort to share your love for God. Thus, you will be rekindling your faith putting off your old self and taking up your new identity. Jesus fills your heart and sets on fire to glorify Him.

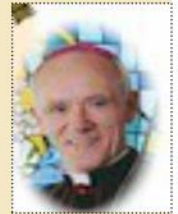

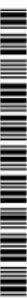

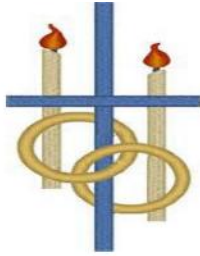
