Zealous Vs Jealous

Dear brothers and sisters,
God's Spirit works through unexpected people. Just as Moses shared his spirit with the seventy elders, God's Spirit is given to all believers, not just a select few. Isaiah said, "All shall be taught by God." Jesus breathed His Spirit on His disciples and commissioned them with a mission to the ends of the earth. Thus the Spirit is given to all who believe in God "for the common good." (1 Cor. 12)

Two of the elders, Eldad and Medad received the spirit of Moses and prophesied in the camp. Joshua wanted to stop them. John saw someone driving out demons in Jesus' name, and wanted stop him. The Spirit was zealous in them all; but Joshua and John were jealous. Both Moses and Jesus said, "Don't stop them." Why do we feel jealous of zealous people who do good in their life?

A fable: An eagle could out fly higher than another and was jealous; asked a sportsman to bring down that eagle. The sportsman replied that he would if he only had some feathers to put into the arrow. The eagle gave from his wings. The arrow was shot, but didn't quite reach the rival eagle. The envious eagle pulled out more feathers, until he lost so many that he couldn't fly, and the sportsman killed the jealous eagle. If you are jealous, the only person you can hurt is yourself; you fail to live your life, kill your spirit, peace and your relationships.

God's spirit is given to us for the good of all. Each of us need to do good in our own way; and ONLY good. If some one is being or doing good, appreciate them, and do not be jealous. Jealousy and zealousness are flip sides of the same coin. Jealous always loses while zealous always wins. Jealous relates to self. Zealous relates to God and His Spirit. (Prov. 23:17-18) Be zealous for the Lord and He will give you the grace to do good; and the jealousy will die by itself.

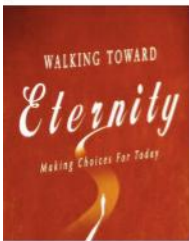

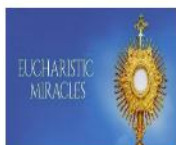

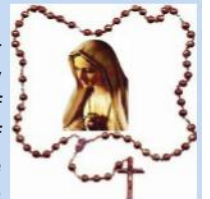

He offers ten practical suggestions for parents to use as they nurture their child's spiritual development:

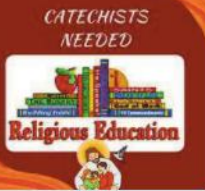
1. Be yourself.

6. Utilize media to launch discussions about God and the Christian life.
7. Have a plan for family devotional and prayer times.
8. Have fun with your kids.
9. Get involved in ministry together as a family.
10. Disciple and equip your kids.
