2. The Magi: Pilgrims of Hope

Dear brothers and sisters,

This weekend we celebrate "The Epiphany of our Lord." The revelation of the Messiah to the Gentiles - the Magi - who were scholars, men of science, keepers of ancient knowledge, important advisers to the kings, experts in astronomy. During their research they saw the "Star of Bethlehem" at the same night of the Nativity of Jesus. These scholars understood the meaning and significance of the Star. They began their pilgrimage to Bethlehem guided by the star!

Herod probably knew the prophecies about a coming Messianic King. The Rabbis taught that he would be a revolutionary who would overthrow Rome. (Micah 5:2) The chief priests and scribes knew about this. (Mt. 2:4-6) But they did not seek the Messiah.

The wise men followed the star that led them to the place where Jesus was living. The wise men always see the signs / hand of God in their lives. This was a special light sent from God to one who reads the signs.

Like these wise men, we need to seek to worship Jesus Christ above everything else in our lives. They left their comfortable homes and honored positions in life to make an 800 mile trek to find and worship the new born King of the Jews, the Messiah. They freely gave valuable treasures to honor Him that they could have used to improve their own life-style. They were pilgrims, pilgrims of Hope. They humbly submitted themselves to a higher King, the source of Wisdom, and decided to serve Him alone.

We are pilgrims on earth. We believe in Christ's presence. Our life at home, at school, at work, in the church, and in the community should reflect our encounter with Christ, the King. Let us seek Jesus in Hope. Blessings! Msgr. Xavier

The Epiphany of The Lord

The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Savior of the world. The word "epiphany" comes from the Greek epiphainen, a verb that means "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known." Thus, the feast of the Epiphany celebrates the many ways that Christ has made Himself known to the world, mainly the three events that manifested the mission and divinity of Christ: the visit of the Magi (Matthew 2:1-12), the baptism of Jesus (Mark 1:9-11), and the miracle at Cana (John 2:1-11).



The Magi brought the Christ Child gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. God was honored and glorified through His creation by the giving of these gifts. God created gold to manifest His beauty and dignity. It was a gift that symbolized kingship. When we ponder the natural gift of gold given to the Christ Child, we are inspired to give Him our own gift of symbolic gold by prayerfully acknowledging Him as our own King to whom we pledge our complete submission. We have planted the shrubs and trees in front of the church on both side of the entrance. Beautiful indeed!

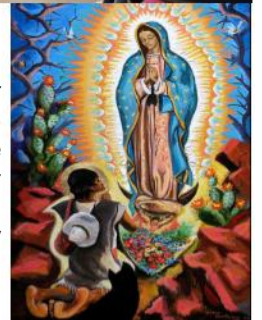
We have also added 6 metal benches for people to relax before and after Masses. Come and try them out as a family and take time to visit. Feel free to make a visit!



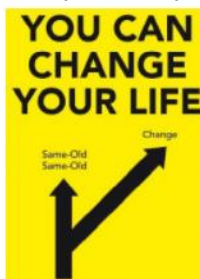

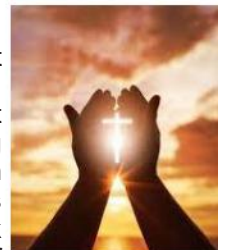
