5. Our Hope is In Our Arms.

Dear brothers and sisters,
We celebrate the Presentation of Our Lord - a day when Mary and Joseph brought the infant Jesus to the temple, fulfilling the law of Moses. This moment marks not only the presentation of a child but the revealing of Hope to the world.

Simeon, a righteous and devout man, had been promised by the Holy Spirit that he would not die before seeing the Messiah. When he sees Jesus, he holds Him in his arms and proclaims: "My eyes have seen Your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations: a light for revelation to the Gentiles and the glory of your people Israel." (Luke 2:30-32) When Simeon holds the baby Jesus in his arms, he is holding the very Hope of Israel - the promise of salvation, light and glory. Simeon sees in the infant Jesus the fulfillment of all the promises God has made, and he is content. His waiting, his longing, his hope are all fulfilled in this moment.



Hope was/is not abstract. It was/is not something distant, but something tangible. He could hold it in his arms. And in doing so, he reveals to us that the hope we have in Christ is real and present. We are called not only to wait for hope but to actively hold onto it/Him and embrace it/Him, just as Simeon did.

This hope is not just about a future reward, but about the present transformation that shapes us, refines us, and molds us into the image of Christ. This hope does not leave us unchanged.

On this feast of the Presentation of Our Lord, let us present our children, who are our hope here on earth and the hope of our families, Hold them not only close to our heart but also close to Christ, the hope of our/their lives. May they see the light of Christ every day!

St. Blaise

Blaise is a saint in the Catholic Church, and is the patron saint of wool combers and of sufferers from ENT illnesses. In the Latin Church, his feast falls on 3 February. According to the *Acta Sanctorum*, he was martyred by being beaten, tortured with iron combs, and beheaded. The first reference to Blaise is the medical writings of Aëtius Amidenus (c. AD 500) where his aid is invoked in treating patients with objects stuck in the throat.



It is said from being a healer of bodily ailments, Saint Blaise was to become an expert on souls, then he retired for a time to a cave, where he remained in prayer. As bishop of Sebastea, Blaise instructed people as much by his example as by his words, and his great virtues and his sanctity were attested to by many miracles. People were said to flock to him for cures of bodily and spiritual ills. He is said to have healed animals, who came to him on their own for his assistance, and in turn to have been helped by animals. He is the patron for ENT illnesses.

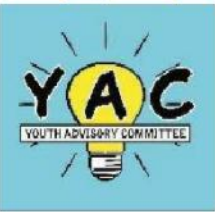
