6. "Our Hope in God's Call"

Hope is a powerful force that can transform despair into purpose and fear into courage. Isaiah's vision and Peter's encounter with Jesus instills hope in the hearts of those He commissions. God's presence, grace, and call bring hope even in moments of doubt and inadequacy.

Most of the time we worry or think on our weaknesses or sinfulness but don't want to acknowledge or accept it. God's presence that give THAT grace to accept it; and transforms human failures and sinfulness into holiness

and divine abundance. We are reminded that His power exceeds our limitations, offering hope in the face of challenges. He meets us where we are and assures us of His transformative power.

God's grace turns fear into courage and invites us into a new purpose: Isaiah to be

a greatest prophet; and Peter to be Foundation of Christ's Church. But GOD waits for our response! When the Lord asks, "Whom shall I send?" He invites us to be involved in His mission. Isaiah replies, "Here I am. Send me!" Peter and his companions left everything and followed Jesus. When we trust in God's call, we find purpose and fulfillment beyond anything we could imagine.

In my personal life, I experienced and continue to experience the power of grace from the moment God called me to be HIS priest – left home with nothing in hand; God provided me with everything I 'needed' from unexpected and unknown people. Today I am what I am in my priesthood only by the grace of God and by you being a blessing to my priesthood. He transforms everyday my weakness into power; and failures into success. All I say is: Here I am, Lord. I will do YOUR will!

I pray that you and your family find THAT hope that God has called you to live for. Wishing you a safe journey of hope.

Reverend Ronald J. Nuzzi, ACE *RISE* (Renewing Identity, Strengthening Evangelization) offers ten reasons why Catholic schools still have an important place in our world.



5. Civic Engagement

In recent research, it has been reported that private school graduates are significantly more likely to actively participate in civic activities than their public school counterparts. Catholic Schools were ranked #1 in the percentage of graduates who actively participate in civic and community activities such as voting, volunteering, letter-writing to legislators, Catholic Concerns Day, and donations to charity, not just for a tax write-off, but out of a sense of the requirements of justice.

6. Service for the Common Good

Catholic schools promote service as an essential component of their curriculum. Many Catholic schools have service programs from kindergarten through twelfth grade. Higher education programs such as the Jesuit or Dominican Volunteer Corps promote service at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Diocesan organizations such as Catholic Family Services provide resources and help to people from all walks of life. Catholic school students learn that since community is at the heart of who we are, there are no strangers, only brothers and sisters in the Lord. We have a responsibility to respond to the needs of others because we are all part of God's family.






