

7. Hope: Blessings or Curses?

Dear brothers and sisters,

A man sentenced to death obtained a reprieve by assuring the king he would teach his majesty's horse to fly within the year - on the condition that if he didn't succeed, he would be put to death at the end of the year. "Within a year," the man explained later, "the king may die, or I may die, or the horse may die. Furthermore, in a year, who knows? Maybe the horse will learn to fly." Be hopeful with positive attitude!

Hope is one of the most powerful forces in human life. It sustains us during difficulties and shapes the way we face challenges. But where and how we place our hope matters - ourselves, our resources, or the world around us? Or in the unshakable promises of God? Which brings our blessings or curses!

Imagine a person trying to quench their thirst with saltwater. The more they drink, the thirstier they become, and it ultimately harms them. Similarly, relying on human strength and worldly solutions only deepens our struggles rather than bringing relief.

The person who places their hope in God is like a tree planted by streams of water, flourishing even during drought because their roots draw from a constant source. Jesus redefines hope, lifting up those who seem to have no reason for it - the poor, the hungry, the sorrowful, and the rejected; whose hope is ONLY God.

Remember, there are no hopeless situations; there are only people who have grown hopeless about them. Hope is a dream of a waking man/woman. Therefore, whether our hope brings blessings or curses depends on us and our hope in God or in passing things/people of the world. Blessings promised by God are ours, if we hope in His grace. Renewing Identity, Strengthening Evangelization offers ten reasons why Catholic schools still have an important place in our world.



5. Civic Engagement

In recent research, it has been reported that private school graduates are significantly more likely to actively participate in civic activities than their public school counterparts. Catholic Schools were ranked #1 in the percentage of graduates who actively participate in civic and community activities such as voting, volunteering, letter-writing to legislators, Catholic Concerns Day, and donations to charity, not just for a tax write-off, but out of a sense of the requirements of justice.

6. Service for the Common Good

Catholic schools promote service as an essential component of their curriculum. Many Catholic schools have service programs from kindergarten through twelfth grade. Higher education programs such as the Jesuit or Dominican Volunteer Corps promote service at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Diocesan organizations such as Catholic Family Services provide resources and help to people from all walks of life. Catholic school students learn that since community is at the heart of who we are, there are no strangers, only brothers and sisters in the Lord. We have a responsibility to respond to the needs of others because we are all part of God's family.
