11. A Covenant of Hope

Dear brothers and sisters,
 On our Lenten journey of Hope, we are given two important events to deepen our faith as pilgrims of hope – a covenant with Abraham and the transfiguration of Jesus.

God reassures Abraham that his descendants will be as numerous as the stars. Abraham believes, and God counts it as righteousness. However, to confirm this promise, a solemn covenant ritual takes place. As Abraham falls into a deep sleep, God alone passes between the sacrificed animals, signifying that the fulfillment of the covenant depends entirely on Him. This moment foreshadows God's ultimate covenant in Christ.



Just as Abraham experienced a deep sleep before God's revelation, the disciples, overwhelmed, also struggle to comprehend the moment. The covenant with Abraham involved bloody sacrifice, foreshadowing Christ's ultimate sacrifice on the Cross that was conversed with Moses and Elijah on Mount Tabor. God calls us into a covenantal relationship, not based on our strength but on His faithfulness. Just as Abraham trusted God's promise, we are called to trust in Christ, the fulfillment of all God's covenants.

A wedding is a powerful illustration of God's covenant with humanity. When a man and woman stand before God/priest as witness and vows to love and remain faithful to each other, they enter into a covenant, not just a contract, but a sacred bond based on commitment, love and trust. Our faith journey involves moments of struggle, but God's glory is revealed through our hope in life.

May we, like Abraham and the disciples, listen to Christ, knowing that He is "a covenant maker and not a crisis solver" in our Lenten journey of hope.

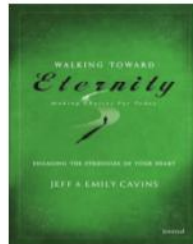

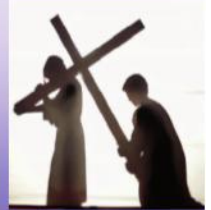

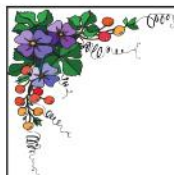

in Mark 6:14-29



If we don't teach our children to FOLLOW GOD'S WAYS the world will teach them NOT TO. Let us be responsible teachers in leading their way.

What can I do ... as a youth ... for Lent?

1. Think about what you usually spend your money on. Do you buy too many clothes? Spend too much on dinner out? Pick one type of expenditure that you'll "fast" from during Lent, and then give the money you would usually spend to a local charity.
2. Take something on — 40 days of letter writing, 40 days of reading Bible, 40 acts of kindness, 40 phone calls to the important people or friends in your life to encourage them.
3. When you first sit down in front of your computer, or at the very end of your day, try a 10-minute guided prayer based on the spiritual exercises of St. Ignatius or any other saint.
4. Go to (or watch) a weekday Mass one day during the week. Daily Masses are often more intimate and shorter than Sunday Mass. Come up with something that reminds you that "God is for you".
5. If you don't have a crucifix in your room or house, get one and pray in front of it before you go to bed; and after you rise in the morning.
