12. Our Hope in God's Mercy

Dear brothers and sisters,
God hears the cries of the Israelites and patiently prepares Moses for the mission of deliverance, revealing Himself through the burning bush, calling him to lead Israel out of slavery. This moment is not only about Moses' mission but also about God's self-revelation as kind and merciful, showing His patient love.

Similarly, the parable of the barren fig tree shows that God is patient but expects transformation. The owner of the fig tree wants to cut it down because it bears no fruit, but the gardener pleads for more time, showing God's patience with sinners. Just as Moses had to respond to God's call, so too must the people in Jesus' time respond to the call to repentance and to lead others to repentance.

St. Monica spent years praying for the conversion of her son, Augustine, who lived a life of sin and worldly pursuits. Despite discouragement, **she never lost hope.** After many years, her prayers were answered - Augustine converted, became a saint, and one of the greatest theologians of the Church.

In His mercy, God gives opportunities for conversion but also expects a response. The barren fig tree will eventually be cut down if it does not bear fruit, just as Pharaoh and Egypt faced consequences when they refused to heed God's call through Moses. God reveals Himself as patient and merciful, but also demands transformation.

Pope Francis says, "Let us be renewed by God's mercy, be enabled to transform our lives; and let us become agents of this mercy." Let us not mistake God's patience for His absence. His timing is perfect and His presence is constant.

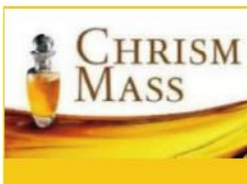
Lenten Confessions at St. Matthew

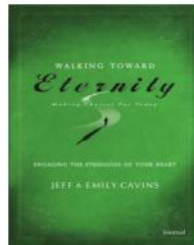

Fasting & Abstinence

Fasting is defined as having one full meal a day, and is required only on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. This requirement is for ages 18 to 59, but younger and older may participate.

During Lent abstinence from meat on Friday's is obligatory in the United States, as elsewhere, for all Catholics age 14 until death.

Getting caught up in the rubrical requirements, however, misses the point. Fasting is meaningless unless our hearts fast from obstacles blocking our way to true discipleship.

YOUTH MINISTRY

Our children may **GO WRONG...**
if we don't **START** them **RIGHT**

Reflect on the story of Herodias and her daughter
in Mark 6:14-29



If we don't teach our children to FOLLOW GOD'S WAYS the world will teach them NOT TO. Let us be responsible teachers in leading their way.

What can I do ... as a youth ... for Lent?

1. Think about what you usually spend your money on. Do you buy too many clothes? Spend too much on dinner out? Pick one type of expenditure that you'll "fast" from during Lent, and then give the money you would usually spend to a local charity.
2. Take something on — 40 days of letter writing, 40 days of reading Bible, 40 acts of kindness, 40 phone calls to the important people or friends in your life to encourage them.
3. When you first sit down in front of your computer, or at the very end of your day, try a 10-minute guided prayer based on the spiritual exercises of St. Ignatius or any other saint.
4. Go to (or watch) a weekday Mass one day during the week. Daily Masses are often more intimate and shorter than Sunday Mass. Come up with something that reminds you that "God is for you".
5. If you don't have a crucifix in your room or house, get one and pray in front of it before you go to bed; and after you rise in the morning.
