14. Hope Opens A New Way

Dear brothers and sisters,

We are in the Fifth Sunday on our Lenten Journey as Pilgrims of Hope. We are turning the corner to a new way with a new beginning that **God is always doing something new in us.** He is not limited by our past, our sins, but leads us forward **making a new way.** The Lord says, "Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?" His saving power is **not bound to our past sins; but He is at work making a new path** in our lives.

We meet a sinful woman whose life seemed over. She was caught in sin, dragged into the temple, and made a public spectacle, and stoned. But they are blind to mercy. They know the letter of the Law, but not its spirit. Jesus comes. He kneels. **He writes a new way.** He says nothing at first. But when He does speak, it is thunderous: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone." Silence. One by one, they walk away dropping their stone - a new way!

And now Jesus, who alone is sinless, is the only one who could condemn her. But what does He say? "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and sin no more." Jesus makes a new way - **not by ignoring sin,** but by conquering it with **mercy and truth.** He doesn't say her sin was acceptable; or "You're fine the way you are." No, He calls her to **conversion,** to a **new life.** That is the "new thing" God is doing: **re-creating us by grace.**

Where in your life do you need Jesus to make a new way? What stone are you still carrying, ready to throw at someone or even at yourself? Jesus invites you to drop the stone and open your heart to a New Way he writes for you!

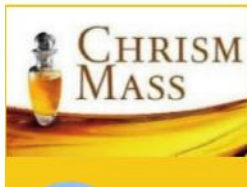

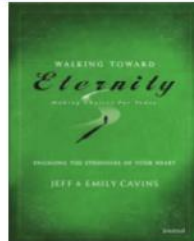

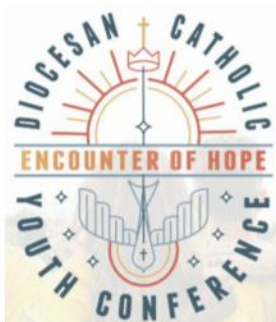

14. La Esperanza Abre Un Nuevo Camino

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Estamos en el quinto domingo de nuestra Cuaresma como Peregrinos de la Esperanza. Damos un paso hacia un nuevo camino con una nueva esperanza, recordando que **Dios siempre está obrando algo nuevo. Él no se limita a nuestro pasado ni a nuestros pecados**, sino que nos guía hacia adelante y crea un nuevo camino. El Señor dice: «No recuerden las cosas pasadas ni piensen en las cosas antiguas. Miren, estoy haciendo algo nuevo; ya está brotando, ¿no lo perciben?». Su poder salvador no está ligado a nuestros pecados pasados; sino que Él está obrando, creando un nuevo camino en nuestras vidas.

Nos encontramos con una mujer pecadora cuya vida parecía estar acabada. Fue sorprendida en pecado, arrastrada al templo, convertida en un espectáculo público y apedreada. Pero ellos están ciegos a la misericordia. Conocen la letra de la Ley, pero no su espíritu. Jesús viene. Se arrodilla. Escribe un nuevo camino. Al principio, no dice nada. Pero cuando habla, es un estruendo: «Que el que esté libre de pecado tire la primera piedra». Silencio. Uno a uno, se van dejando caer la piedra: ¡un nuevo camino!

Y ahora Jesús, el único sin pecado, es el único que podía condenarla. Pero ¿qué dice? «Yo tampoco te condeno. Vete y no peques más». Jesús abre un nuevo camino, no ignorando el pecado, sino venciendo con misericordia y verdad. No dice que su pecado era aceptable; ni «Estás bien como estás». No, la llama a la conversión, a una nueva vida. Esa es la «nueva obra» que Dios está haciendo: recreándonos por gracia.

¿En qué aspectos de tu vida necesitas que Jesús abra un nuevo camino? ¿Qué piedra sigues cargando, lista para lanzársela a alguien o incluso a ti misma? ¡Jesús te invita a dejar la piedra y abrir tu corazón a un Nuevo Camino que él escribe para ti!

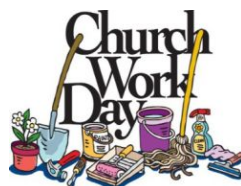

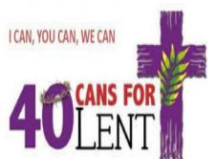
